- The aerators will be running 24/7 for a few weeks instead of the usual 8pm to 8am. It appears that at least one of the aeration diffusor heads is not working properly which is affecting water circulation.
- We will be cleaning or replacing the aeration diffuser heads in mid-June. As stated in last month's news letter, it will take a while for the pond to recover after its drainage last year.
- There is algae in the pond and I have contacted EcoResources about algal mitigation.
- The compressor station was making an unusual noise due to a faulty fan. If you hear a noise coming from the compressor station that does not sound normal, please text Valerie at 970-417-7024.
